Anthropogenic Tropical Forests May 12 2021 The studies in this volume provide an ethnography of a plantation frontier in central Sarawak, Malaysian Borneo. Drawing on the expertise of both natural scientists and social scientists, the key focus is the process of commodification of nature that has turned the local landscape into anthropogenic tropical forests. The key transitional questions to get there include: [the benefits that can be afforded and their impacts on health outcomes and financial protection; [how the more than 50 percent of those currently without coverage will be insured; [how to pay medical care providers to assure access, efficiency, and quality; [developing a streamlined and efficient administrative structure; [how to address the current supply constraints to assure availability of promised services; [how to raise revenues to finance the system, including the program for the poor as well as currently uninsured groups that may require government subsidization such as the more than 60 million informal sector workers, the 85 percent of workers in firms of less than five employees, and the 70 percent of the population living in rural areas.

Public Service Broadcasting and Post-Authoritarian Indonesia Mar 22 2022 This book investigates public service broadcasting (PSB) models in post-authoritarian regimes, and offers a critical inspection of the development of a Western European-originated PSB system in Asian transitional societies, in particular in Indonesia since the 1990's. Placing the case of Indonesia's PSB within the context of global media liberalization, this book traces the development of public

It explores the history of broadcast governance in authoritarian Indonesia, and considers how Western European PSB or 'British Broadcasting Corporation/BBC-like' models have travelled – somewhat uneasily – to new democracies, but also how autocratic legacies embedded in former state-owned radio and television channels have resisted external parties of pro-democratic media systems.

The Riau Islands Sep 03 2020 To Singapore's immediate south, Indonesia's Riau Islands has a population of 2 million and a land area of 8,200 sq kilometers scattered across some 2,000 islands.
